As a reminder, we will have the Bible Quiz and the teaching and preaching competitions again this year. Bible Quiz will have 5 people per team, and each church is allowed a max of 2 teams. It will consist of questions from the book of James.

Teaching will be for Jr and Sr High ladies. (Please remember to bring extra outlines for judges)

Preaching will be for Jr and Sr high guys. (Please remember to bring extra outlines for judges)

Helpful Information to Know

Grand Canyon State Baptist Camp maintains an emphasis on conduct and attire. We reserve the right to ask and expect any camper to change their behavior or clothing if deemed inappropriate.

Bring: Bible, notebook, pen, flashlight, bedding/sleeping bag (single bunk beds), towels, washcloths, toiletries, reusable water bottle, good shoes for activities, and other personal items. You will need money for snacks. Jackets or sweatshirts are helpful for cool evenings and mornings.

Do Not Bring: Cell phones, video games, knives, or firearms. No smoking. No pets.

Dating: No physical contact is allowed between campers of opposite genders. All campers are required to stay in supervised areas.

Guys Clothing: Loose-fitting, knee-length shorts, jeans/pants are acceptable for recreational activities and morning services. Nice casual clothing (no shorts) with a collared shirt should be worn to the evening services. All shirts must have sleeves: no tank tops. Avoid wearing clothing with inappropriate advertising.

Girls Clothing: Loose-fitting, knee-length shorts, jeans/pants are acceptable for recreational activities and morning services. Leggings/jeggings are not permitted. Shirts must have sleeves (no tank tops or spaghetti strap tops). Avoid wearing clothing with inappropriate advertisements and logos. Casual skirts or dresses (no shorts or pants) must come to the middle of the knee and are to be worn to the evening services.

Dodgeball Rules: (50 min) Gym

1 round of guys

1 round of girls

1 round of co-ed

Points will only count on these 3 games. (If time permits, more games can be played for fun until time is up)

Head shots-no one is out

Caught ball-person who threw the ball is out (even if it is deflected)

If ball hits the ground or wall first-no one is out

If you try to deflect a ball with a ball and drop it, you are out.

If a ball hits you, pops up in the air and is caught by another team member, both are safe and the person who threw the ball is out.

Referee will call jail break 1x per game (everyone is able to get back in game)

Game will start with dodgeballs in the middle. After the whistle blows, teens can run and grab a ball, but must go back to their starting positions before throwing a ball.

Volleyball Rules: (50 min) Outdoor Court

The team will consist of 6 players and a coin toss will determine who starts with the ball.

1 round of girls

1 round of guys

1 round of co-ed

Points will only count on these 3 games. (If time permits, more games can be played for fun until time is up)

Game will end when 1 team reaches 15 points by rally score (point on every serve) (must win by 2 points)

Ball is allowed to touch the net on a serve.

If the ball hits the line, it is considered in.

Basketball Rules: (50 min) Outdoor Court

The team will consist of 5 players per team. Full court

1 guys game

1 girls game

Subs will be allowed

The game will consist of 2–8-minute halves (running clock) with a 3-minute halftime.

1-1-minute time out per half may be called per team.

Fouls:

Non-shooting foul will result in the ball being taken out of bounds

Shooting fouls will result in 1 free throw and retain possession upon made free throw. If a free throw is missed, live play is resumed with the rebounding team.

If the shot is made on a foul (and 1) then play continues as normal after the free throw.

If needed, a 4-minute overtime will be used to determine the winner.

If time runs out and the allotted 50 minutes are up, then both teams will receive points and the game will end in a tie.

Flag Football Rules: (50 min) Field

Teams will consist of an even number of kids up to 14 per team and a coin toss will determine who starts with the ball.

Subs are allowed

1 guys game

1 girls game

The game will consist of 2–8-minute halves (running clock) with a 3-minute halftime.

1-1-minute time out per half may be called per team.

If overtime is needed:

Each team will possess the ball and have a chance to score from a designated spot on the field. (4 downs only)

If multiple overtimes are needed, then the designated spot will continue to get farther away in each overtime. This will continue until one team fails to score on their possession.

If time runs out and the allotted 50 minutes are up, then both teams will receive points, and the game will end in a tie.
